



# £10,000 RAISED WITH OVER £8000 PROFIT FOR THE CHARITIES

In just over a year since the main fund-raising started, the treasurer of SSG announced that we have banked over £10,000! A staggering amount for one small village. Here is the events list to date.

## Events held

September 2001: coffee and cakes morning raised £100.
January-March 2002: collection of foreign notes and coins cashed in to the total of £565. The group donated £100 to each of the five charities.

January 2002: Charity Supper with representatives from each of the five charities. £688 was raised.

April 2002: Ladies Fashion Night, Wycombe Town Hall. In conjunction with Spring Grand Draw just over £2,400 raised.

April 2002: London Marathon Man, Ian Waterman raised £2,200 September/November 2002: Christmas Merchandise sales sold a total of £850 worth of goods between the charities
