



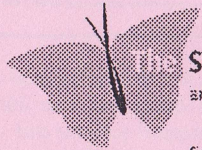

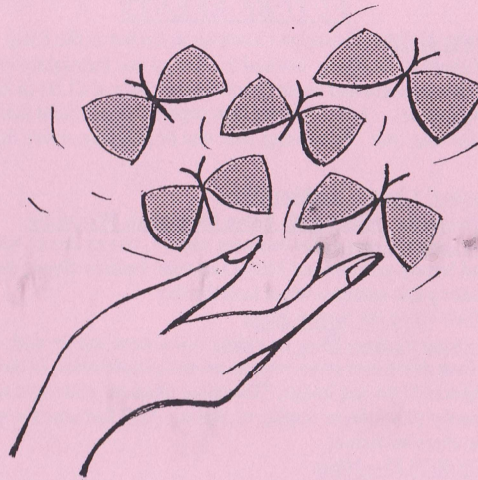

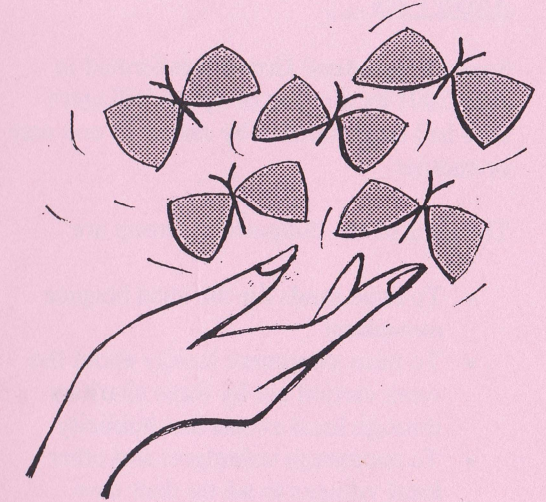

## Events to Date

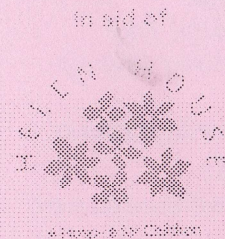
In September, the Group held a coffee morning, gathering local residents together for a chat, coffee, bring-and-buy and cake sale—this raised £100.

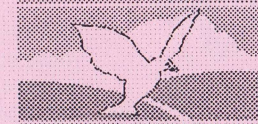

Running costs exceed £1 million per year, and this year the Friends of Florence Nightingale House have pledged to provide £309,000 towards these costs.

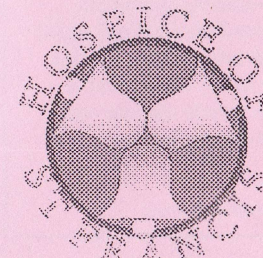
