



# A HISTORY OF SPEEN



“The Leaves of Time” was first published in 2000 as part of Speen’s Millennium Celebrations and is a history of the village and its inhabitants since records began. It records the building of Speen Chapel as well as the birth of our school, the origins of the ‘bodger’ and Speen’s brush with the Second World War! It is a fascinating account of the self-reliance of the inhabitants of this remote hilltop village.

Updated in 2007, this edition records subsequent events in the village such as the school’s 40<sup>th</sup> birthday, the opening of the children’s bike park, the numerous S.S.G’s (Speen Supporters Group) fundraising events and of course the biennial SPEEN FESTIVAL with its art and photographic exhibitions, plays and musicals. Proceeds of the sale of the books are shared 50/50 between the Speen Heritage Group and Speen Helping Hospices.
