SPEEN HELPING HOSPICES

Speen Helping Hospices (SHH) is a small fundraising initiative run by a group from Speen and North Dean to fundraise for four local hospices - Florence Nightingale, Rennie Grove, South Bucks Hospice and Helen House, the hospice for children in Oxford.

The hospices provide a range of palliative and end-of-life care services to people in Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire. The hospices receive limited funds and are increasingly reliant on local support from communities like ours to continue to provide the specialist care of inpatient and day hospice services.

The hospices are continuously improving care provision and offering

support in many ways in response to feedback. However, this increases expenditure and with limited state support their funding gap is ongoing and the events organised and supported by the village make an important contribution.

At SHH we keep overheads down to an absolute minimum to ensure that the money raised goes directly to the charities.
